

Funeral Arrangements

The Rector considers it a pastoral privilege to visit with you about this subject and to explain these details and answer any questions that you may have concerning funeral arrangements.

The death of a member of the Church should be reported as soon as possible to, and arrangements for the funeral should be made in consultation with, the Rector.

The normal order of service is Christian Burial is within the Holy Eucharist from the Book of Common Prayer. The Burial Office without the Holy Eucharist is an option (Book of Common Prayer 491-500, 361-366)


Music for Christian burials is, appropriately, from the Christian musical repertoire. Several burial hymns are available in the Hymnal 1982, and Easter music (that is, music celebrating the Resurrection) is likewise quite appropriate. The Rector and Director of Music are available for guidance in choosing liturgically appropriate music.

Baptized Christians are properly buried from the church. The service should be held at a time when the congregation has opportunity to be present. The coffin is to be closed before the service, and it remains closed thereafter. It is appropriate that it be covered with a pall, provided by the church.

If the deceased:

- * Was a Veteran, the flag may be placed on the coffin <u>prior</u> to the service; the flag is then replaced by the pall before the service begins.
- * Belonged to a fraternal organization and you want them to participate in funeral rites, this activity occurs at a time <u>separate</u> from the Eucharist.

Please complete the attached form with the Rector, so that details can be discussed, and questions clarified. Thank you for pre-planning your funeral arrangements; doing so is sensitive to your family and helps to ensure that your wishes are followed.






Other Considerations
